Transitions of Care is a specialty collaboration between ACMH and New York Presbyterian (NYP) Hospital System providing time-limited intensive care coordination for targeted patients who are high utilizers of emergency services. Responsible for outreach, engagement and the development & implementation of a comprehensive care coordination plan for assigned caseload. Transitions of Care staff work as a team with NYP staff to improve client health outcomes. Responsibilities include working with clients to identify barriers and develop skill sets and self-management goals. Care Coordinators facilitate access to treatment and promote effective communication among those involved in a client's care. Care Coordinators conduct home visits, make referrals and assure transition care planning and follow-up.
