- Ana's House in Morrisania, in the Bronx




ACMH's permanent apartment buildings include units for young adults, ages 18-25, promoting positive youth development, as well as affordable units for community households.



Crisis Respite and Step-Down Housing

Garden House and Independence House offer a short-term stay in a home-like setting with round-the-clock peer support for guests experiencing crisis or transitioning from hospitalization.



Priority for transitional and permanent housing is for those who are homeless or leaving hospitals, State psychiatric centers, or incarceration.
